We are looking for musicians and performers with CARIBBEAN, AFRO/CARIBBEAN, AFRO LATIN and AFRO/WORLD content, which will project the image and diversity of the Caribbean region. Performances to be awarded include our Open-air concert, indoor concert, dance hall stage, parade float and easy listening.

Compensation: Performers are given HONORARIUMS which are funded primarily by a provincial gaming grant and the fundraising efforts (proceeds from concessions) of the T&T Cultural Society. There is no cover charge or entrance fee.

- Two reviews (optional)
- A representative sample of your work
- Musicians: CD or tape
- Dance groups: one VHS videotape
